Walter Day of Bagley dies at 89

Walter E. Day, 89, Bagley, Minn., retired veteran member of the Minnesota Legislative Congregational Church at Bagley, died Sunday in Bethesda Hospital at Crookston, Minn.

At time of death he was president of the Garden Valley Telephone Co., Erskine, Minn.; president of the Farmers Publishing Co. at Bagley, and a member of the Minnesota Society of Mayflower Descendants. He also was a member of the First Congregational Church at Bagley.

He had lived in Clearwater County since 1900. He was elected to his first term in the Minnesota Legislature in 1919 and continued as a member for approximately 40 years.

His interest in conservation at one time won him the "Keep Minnesota Green" award.

Survivors include two sons, Maurice, Sault Ste. Marie, Mich., and Evan of St. Paul; five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; a brother, Benjamin, Portland, Ore., and a sister, Mrs. Dillon Tierney, Chisago City, Minn.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the First Congregational Church at Bagley.
