REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 107

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization is made with prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, certain powers and duties of the Department and Commissioner of Transportation related to railroad track scales are transferred to the Director and Department of Public Service as following described. Transferred are the specific powers and duties described in Minnesota Statutes, Section 218.041, Subdivision 3(6), 4(1), and 6(2), (3), and to the extent necessary those powers and duties necessary to effectuate the aforementioned.

No positions are transferred.

No moneys are transferred.

This reorganization Order supersedes Reorganization Order No. 106 filed August 6, 1979. In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 16.125, this order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
