REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 117

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization order is made with prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency in state government, the responsibility for approving municipal industrial development projects is transferred from the Commissioner of Securities and Real Estate to the Commissioner of the Department of Energy, Planning, and Development. Transferred are the specific powers and duties described in Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 474.01, Subdivisions 7(a) and 7(b), and to the extent necessary those powers and duties necessary to effectuate the aforementioned.

No positions are transferred.

No moneys are transferred.

Equipment, furnishings, and supplies shall be appropriately transferred as agreed by the involved agencies.

Any lease or other contractual agreement shall be amended to reflect the change in responsible agency.


The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125.




