REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 119

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization order is made with prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the State of Minnesota "Self Help" Productivity Improvement Program, with all its powers and authorities, is transferred from the Department of Finance to the Department of Administration.

Included in the transfer are two positions and incumbents, with all accrued benefits:

The legislative authorized complement of the Department of Finance is reduced by one full-time position and one half-time position. The legislative authorized complement of the Department of Administration is hereby increased by one full-time employee and one half-time employee.

All project monies associated with the federal grant are hereby transferred. Equipment, supplies, and furnishings shall be appropriately transferred as agreed by the involved agencies. Any lease or other contractual agreement shall be amended to reflect the change in responsible agency.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 16.125, Subdivision 3.

The effective date of this order is January 12, 1982. The order is herewith filed with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
