REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 131

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1982, Section 16.125, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and to avoid duplication in the operation of state government, industrial hygiene testing and enforcement duties of the Commissioner of Labor and Industry for the Employee Right-to-Know and the Federal Hazard Communication Standard Programs are transferred to the Commissioner of Health.

Two half-time complement positions, one funded by the General Fund and one funded by federal monies, are transferred from the Department of Labor and Industry to the Department of Health. The legislative complement of the Department of Labor and Industry is hereby decreased by one full-time equivalent position. The legislative complement of the Department of Health is hereby increased by one full-time equivalent position.


The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1982, Section 16.125, Subdivision 3.

The effective date of this order is April 2, 1984. The order is herewith filed with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.




