REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 160

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the Department of Finance's powers and duties relating to the personnel functions of the personnel/payroll computer system are transferred to the Department of Employee Relations.

No personnel are transferred.

The Department of Finance shall give to the Department of Employee Relations all contracts, books, maps, plans, papers, records, supplies, and equipment relating to the transferred powers and duties.

The Department of Employee Relations is the legal successor in all respects of the Department of Finance in regard to the transferred powers and duties. The bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Department of Finance become the bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Department of Employee Relations.

Any proceeding, court action, prosecution, or other business or matter pending on the effective date of the transfer may be conducted and completed by the Department of Employee Relations in the same manner under the same terms and conditions, and with the same effect, as though it involved or were commenced and conducted or completed prior to the transfer by the Department of Finance.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, subdivision 3.

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, subdivision 2, this order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.


