REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 161

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, position number 131680, which is currently vacant, is transferred from the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board (IRRBB) to the Attorney General's Office. The position shall be used to provide legal services to the IRRBB.

The legislatively authorized complement of the IRRBB is decreased by one position; the complement of the Attorney General's Office as provided by Laws 1988, Chapter 335, Article 1, Section 12, is increased by one position.

The IRRBB shall provide office space, equipment, furnishings, supplies, and other staff support for the transferred position.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, subdivision 3.

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1988, Section 16B.37, subdivision 2, this order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed.
