REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 171

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the powers and duties of the Commissioner of the Department of Children, Families, and Learning, transferred from the Commissioner of Education, under Minnesota Laws 1995, First Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 16, for the approval or use of discretionary grant funds either applied for or administered by the Parent Advisory Coalition for Educational Rights (PACER), are transferred to the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning.

No personnel or staff positions are transferred.

The Commissioner of Children, Families, and Learning shall give to the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning all contracts, books, maps, plans, papers, records, supplies, and equipment relating to the transferred powers.


The Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning is the legal successor in all respects of the Commissioner of Children, Families, and Learning in regard to the transferred duties. The bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Commissioner of Children, Families, and Learning become the bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning.


Any proceeding, court action, prosecution, or other business or matter pending on the effective date of the transfer may be conducted and completed by the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning in the same manner under the same terms and conditions, and with the same effect, as though it involved or were commenced and conducted or completed prior to the transfer by the Commissioner of Children, Families and Learning.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, subdivision 3.

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, subdivision 2, this order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and remains in effect until amended or superseded.


