

**STATE OF MINNESOTA
DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION
REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 172**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission's duties for the construction of an indoor national shooting sports center under Laws of Minnesota 1994, Chapter 643, Section 4, Subdivision 4, are transferred to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources.

Consistent with this transfer of duties, the appropriation to the Amateur Sports Commission provided under Laws of Minnesota 1994, Chapter 643, Section 4, Subdivision 4, for the construction of the indoor national shooting sports center is transferred to the Department of Natural Resources.

No personnel or staff positions are transferred.

The Amateur Sports Commission shall give to the Department of Natural Resources all contracts, books, maps, plans, papers, records, supplies, and equipment relating to the transferred activities.

The Department of Natural Resources is the legal successor in all respects of the Amateur Sports Commission in regard to the transferred duties. The bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Amateur Sports Commission become the bonds, resolutions, contracts, and liabilities of the Department of Natural Resources.

Any proceeding, court action, prosecution, or other business or matter pending on the effective date of the transfer may be conducted and completed by the Department of Natural Resources in the same manner under the same terms and conditions, and with the same effect, as though it involved or were commenced and conducted or completed prior to the transfer by the Amateur Sports Commission.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, subdivision 3.

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 16B.37, subdivision 2, this order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
