REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 178

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1994, section 16B.37, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, Reorganization Order No. 171 is rescinded. The powers and duties of the Director of the Office of Strategic and Long-Range Planning for the approval or use of discretionary grant funds either applied for or administered by the Parent Advisory Coalition for Educational Rights (PACER), are transferred to the Commissioner of the Department of Children, Families and Learning.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, section 16B.37, subdivision 3.

This Reorganization Order supersedes Reorganization Order No. 171, filed November 2, 1995.

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, section 16B.37, subdivision 2, this Order is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
