The functions related to the approval of applications for Federal grants-in-aids and the analysis of the fiscal impact of non State funding upon the State budgets will be the responsibility of the Department of Finance.

The following two vacant position of the State Planning Agency (Appropriation Account #12001:00-01, AID #600635) are transferred to the Department of Finance (Appropriation Account #11000:21-10). The amount transferred is based upon the amount needed for F.Y. 1976 and the amount appropriated in F.Y. 1977 for the following two positions:
