REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 96

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, 1977 Supplement, Section 16.125, as amended by Laws 1973, Chapter 793, Sections 42 and 43, the following administrative reorganization is made with the prior approval of the Governor.

In order to improve efficiency and avoid duplication in the operation of state government, the Special Tax Crime Control Unit and its functions with the following positions and their incumbents with all accrued benefits are transferred from the Department of Revenue to the Department of Public Safety.

The complement of the Department of Public Safety is increased by five positions (2-General, 3-Federal). The complement of the Department of Revenue is decreased by five positions.

Any grant agreement or other contract that is outstanding shall be amended to reflect the change in responsible state agency.

Equipment, furnishings, and supplies shall be appropriately transferred.

The Commissioner of Finance shall make the necessary financial determinations in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, 1977 Supplement, Section 16.125, as amended by Laws 1978, Chapter 793, Sections 42 and 43.

The effective date of this order is July 1, 1978, and in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, 1977 Supplement, Section 16.125, Subdivision 2, the order shall remain in effect until amended or superseded.
