PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE

TO the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Winona, Minnesota:

The undersigned voters, who have resided in the territory hereinafter described continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date of this petition, hereby petition your Board to call an election and fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporation of such territory as a village to be known by the name of Village of Stockton.

The territory proposed to be incorporated is all situate in township one hundred seven (107), north, range eight (8), west, in the Township of Hillsdale, County of Winona, State of Minnesota, and is more particularly described as follows:

All of section thirty-four (34), and the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-five (35).

This territory consists of land which has been partly platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State and have been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of Winona County, Minnesota; the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

The territory contains 880 acres of land and has 66 actual residents thereon, as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 23 day of June, 1947, as appears by the verification hereto.

2 adoption:

3 WHEREAS, a petition for the incorporation of the Village of Stockton, in the
4 County of Winona, Minnesota, has been presented to, carefully examined by and
5 considered by this Board, and

6 WHEREAS, the said petition conforms to and contains the information required
7 by law;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of
9 Winona County, Minnesota, that:

10 1. The petition is hereby approved;

11 2. an election is hereby called to be held on the 5th day of August
12 1947, between the hours of 9 A. M., and 8 P. M., of said date in the Town Hall
13 in the Village of Stockton, Winona County, Minnesota

14 within the territory described in the petition for the purpose of enabling the
15 voters of said territory to vote for or against such incorporation;

16 3. the following residents within said territory are hereby appointed In-
17 spectors who shall act as Judges of said Election and conduct the same in accord-
18 ance with law, viz: Alvin Burfeind, Ralph Benicke, Anthony Schell ;

19 4. Chester Johnson is hereby appointed and directed to post a
20 Notice of Election, with a copy of the petition for incorporation presented to
21 this Board thereto attached stating the time and place when and where the voters
22 thereof will vote for or against such incorporation;

23 5. ballots shall be prepared bearing the following words, "For Incorporation -
24 Yes - No," with a square after each of the last two words, in one of which the
25 voter shall make a cross to express his choice and such ballots shall contain
26 additional information as to the territory and the boundaries thereof upon which
27 the above entitled question of incorporation shall be voted;

28 6. the inspectors shall immediately after such election make and file with the
29 County Auditor a certificate declaring the time and place of holding said election,
30 and that they have canvassed the ballots cast thereat and the number cast for and
31 against said proposition which said certificate shall be signed and verified by
32 at least two of said inspectors to the effect that the statements contained therein

1 are true.

2 7. the County Auditor shall thereafter attach said certificate to the
3 original petition presented to this Board with a copy of this resolution and
4 original proofs of posting notice of said election and file the whole in his
5 office as one document.

6 The Motion was seconded by Commissioner T. J. Followski and upon
7 being put to a vote was unanimously adopted.
