A Proclamation for Open Book

WHEREAS, the student project for unity among nations was begun at the University of Minnesota in 1945; and

WHEREAS, this program provides for the sending of a group of students abroad for the purpose of study and development of better understanding with the people of other nations; and

WHEREAS, this certificate and commensable order has now been expanded to include ten colleges in Minnesota and to send 100 students abroad each year; and

WHEREAS, students participating in this program are making a most valuable contribution to the State by reporting to their fellow citizens on their experiences and observations, so as to create new appreciation of our close ties with the people of other nations;

I, THOMAS J. HENRY, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 29 to 28 as

OPEN BOOK

and urge all citizens to consider the benefits of OPEN BOOK and to cooperate in the attainment of its objectives, as an important means of building good will between the United States and other nations of the world.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this 21th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine and of the State, the sixty-first.
