


IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE

O R D E R


WHEREAS, The Honorable Edmund A. Montgomery, Judge of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Minnesota, did, on the 15th day of July, 1949, file an application under Laws 1949, Chapter 640, for retirement thereunder, and did make it to appear that he is now, and, on the effective date of said chapter 640, was serving as one of the Judges of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District in the State of Minnesota; that he has attained the age of 73 years or more; that he has completed fifteen years of service as such Judge; that he applied for said retirement within one year after becoming eligible;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to said chapter 640, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the said Edmund A. Montgomery as Judge of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Minnesota, and direct that this order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota at 11 o'clock A.M., August 5th, 1949, at which time said retirement shall become effective and a vacancy in said office shall occur in accordance with said chapter 640, section 1, subdivision 3.
