
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, and the written request of the Commissioner of Taxation, do hereby constitute and appoint W. W. Koons, of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for the Department of Taxation, for the period commencing January 2, 1951, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and, on the recommendation of said department, I hereby fix the compensation of said W. W. Koons as such Special Attorney for the Department of Taxation at the sum of Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty Dollars (\$4,980.00) per year, to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Taxation.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at Saint Paul, Minnesota, this 2nd day of January, 1951.




