A Proclamation for "Israel Bond Month"

WHEREAS, the State of Israel has demonstrated the devotion to freedom and human rights which the United States of America recognizes as essential to the preservation of democracy throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the State of Israel is issuing bonds to the amount of \$500,000,000 in the United States for the purpose of strengthening its role as an outpost of freedom and building a strong and self-sufficient national economy; and

WHEREAS, the Israel Bond Issue will enable the nation to absorb an additional 500,000 immigrants in the next three years, in fulfillment of the humanitarian aims of the country; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Minnesota, of all creeds, have repeatedly identified themselves with the democratic aims of the State of Israel;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Luther W. Youngdahl, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period beginning June 1, 1951, and ending June 30, 1951, as

"ISRAEL BOND MONTH"

and urge full support to the State of Israel Independence Bond Issue to ensure the successful completion of that nation's National Development Plan."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one and of the state, the ninety-fourth.
