WHEREAS, the trucking industry has invited the people of Minnesota to attend this show, without charge, and watch expert truck drivers compete in contests designed to encourage safety among professional truck drivers; and

WHEREAS, these drivers have demonstrated their proficiency by maintaining accident-free records over Minnesota highways for the past 12 months; and


WHEREAS, the winners of this competition will represent Minnesota in the National Truck Roadco in Chicago, Illinois, October 22-26;

in recognition of the important contribution of the Truck Roadco to the highway safety education program of the state.


