A Proclamation for "Steuben Day"

WHEREAS, the 17th day of September is the birthdate of General Friedrich Von Steuben; and

WHEREAS, it is highly fitting that we should honor the memory of General Von Steuben, who, through his distinguished services as Inspector General of the American Army under George Washington, gave magnificent help in the fight for freedom of this nation; and

WHEREAS, the Steuben Society of America, which claims many citizens of Minnesota as members, is planning special programs in tribute to the memory of General Von Steuben on the occasion of his birthdate;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 17, 1951, as

"STEUBEN DAY"

in honor of General Friedrich Von Steuben and the noble assistance that he gave in the founding of our nation.
