WHEREAS, the month of October has been designated by the Minnesota Association of Cooperatives as a special time in which to call public attention to the place of the Co-operative in the economic life of our state; and

WHEREAS, the theme of this observance, "Partners in Progress," stresses the important role of the Cooperative as one of the types of business enterprises that has contributed to the economic growth of our state; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota ranks first among the states in the total number of operating Cooperatives, as well as in the volume of business conducted by Cooperatives;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1951, as

"COOPERATIVE MONTH"

in recognition of the role of Cooperatives in the economy of our State.
