Dear Governor Anderson:

In accordance with Section 2, Chapter 672, Laws of Minnesota for 1951, the first annual report of the Minnesota Board of Examiners of Psychologists for the period July 1, 1951 - June 30, 1952 is submitted herewith.

The members of the board appointed by Honorable Luther W. Youngdahl on August 7, 1951 were Willis B. Dugan, William H. Hales, Clifford B. Jurgenson, John S. Pearson, Sister Annette Walters, Daniel M. Wiener, and C. Gilbert Wrenn. Mr. Timothy C. Keefe qualified as successor to the retiring member, Sister Annette Walters, on May 27, 1952. The board convened for its first meeting on September 17, 1951 and met regularly thereafter during the year for a total of 14 meetings exclusive of sub-committee meetings. Officers elected by the board included William H. Hales, Chairman; Sister Annette Walters, Vice Chairman; and John S. Pearson, Secretary-Treasurer. Daniel M. Wiener was elected to succeed Sister Annette Walters as Vice Chairman upon her retirement from the board.

During the year the board granted certificates to 145 psychologists under the terms of section 4 of the law cited above. A list of names of certificants and their registry numbers is appended. One certificate (No. 40) was voided by reason of the applicant's death prior to issuance of the certificate. The fee of fifteen dollars was refunded to the widow. No certificates were revoked.

Each member of the board has been paid a fee of three dollars for each official meeting attended. John S. Pearson, Secretary-Treasurer, has been employed part time on an overtime basis. His duties include preparation and maintenance of records of the proceedings of the board, supervision of office procedures, preparation of quarterly budgets, requisitioning of supplies, handling of general correspondence, and other related duties. His compensation for this work during the year totaled \$199.50. Mrs. Marilyn G. Short, Clerk Stone II, has been employed part time on an overtime basis to handle general clerical and secretarial work of the board. Her compensation for the year totaled \$208.86. Miss Dolores Klem, Clerk Stone I, has been employed part time on an overtime basis to do hand lettering of the names on certificates issued by the board. Her compensation for the year totaled \$46.20.

An accounting of funds received and expended by the board is presented on the balance sheet attached hereto. Relative to recommendations for the future, the board wishes to call attention to the fact that in all its operations it has been subject to the provisions of the state reorganization act of 1939 since the Attorney General has ruled that this is the case inasmuch as the law does not specifically exclude us from these provisions. We feel that legislative action is necessary to correct this oversight since operation of such a small unit by these means is uneconomical and irksome not only for the board but also for the Civil Service Department, the Department of Administration, the State Treasurer, and the State Auditor.

We also feel that the law should be strengthened and improved by providing for renewal of certificates, notification of change of address of certificants, transmittal to the Governor of a list of persons qualified to fill unexpired terms when vacancies arise, and providing for suspension of certificates by the board as an alternative to revocation in certain instances. It is our hope that the 1953 Legislature will consider our wishes in these matters.
