That part of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Six (6), Township Thirty-one (31), Range Twenty-Four (24) lying North and Easterly of the Great Northern and Northern Pacific Railroad tracks, containing Twenty and Sixty Hundredths (20.60) acres, more or less, according to the United States Government Survey thereof.

to have said property annexed to the City of Anoka, said tract, piece and parcel of land is hereby declared an addition to the City of Anoka.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.




