


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 8.06, do hereby, on request of the Acting Director of Social Welfare, constitute and appoint HAROLD S. BJORNSTAD of Saint Paul, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000) per annum, to be paid from and out of funds appropriated to said Division of Social Welfare. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 5th day of January, 1953.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 27th day of December, 1952.


