In the matter of the incorporation of certain territory
in the County of Hennepin and State of Minnesota, into
a Village to be known as the Village of Rogers, Hennepin PETITION.
County, Minnesota.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners
of the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota.

Your petitioners respectfully show:

That a portion of the lands so to be incorporated have been
platted into lots and blocks and the plat thereof has been duly and
legally certified to according to the laws of the State of Minnesota
and has been filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said
County where said lands lie. That the nucleus of said proposed Village
is in the platted land known as the Townsite of Rogers.

That the Southwest quarter of Section thirteen (13); the
South half of section fourteen (14); the Southeast quarter of Section
fifteen (15) the East one-half of Section twenty-two (22); all of
Section twenty-three and West half of Section twenty-four (24); all
in Township one hundred and twenty (120); of Range twenty-three (23),
West of the 5th, Meridian being in the Town of Hassan of said County
and State and more fully described by their boundaries, courses and
distances as follows; viz

Commencing at a point in the center of Section thirteen (13) of said
Town and Range running thence West along the North line of the South-
West quarter of said Section thirteen (13) and the North line of the South-
half of Section fourteen (14); and the North line of the South-
east quarter of Section (15); to the center of said Section
Fifteen (15), thence at right angles South along the West line of the
Southeast quarter of said Section (15) and the West line of the
East half of Section twenty-two (22) to the quarter section corner on
the South line of said Section twenty-two (22), thence at right angles
East along the South line of the Southeast quarter of Section twenty-two
(22) and the South line of Section twenty-three (23), and the South line
of the Southwest quarter of Section twenty-four (24) to the Southeast
corner of said quarter section; thence at right angles North along the
East line of the West half of said Section twenty-four (24), and the
East line of the Southwest quarter of Section thirteen (13) to the

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County where said lands lie. That the nucleus of said proposed Village
is in the platted land known as the Townsite of Rogers.

That the Southwest quarter of Section thirteen (13); the
South half of section fourteen (14); the Southeast quarter of Section
fifteen (15) the East one-half of Section twenty-two (22); all of
Section twenty-three and West half of Section twenty-four (24); all
in Township one hundred and twenty (120); of Range twenty-three (23),
West of the 5th, Meridian being in the Town of Hassan of said County
and State and more fully described by their boundaries, courses and
distances as follows: viz

Commencing at a point in the center of Section thirteen (13) of said
Town and Range running thence West along the North line of the South-
West quarter of said Section thirteen (13) and the North line of the
South half of Section fourteen (14); and the North line of the South-
east quarter of Section (15); to the center of said Section
Fifteen (15), thence at right angles South along the West line of the
Southeast quarter of said Section (15) and the West line of the
East half of Section twenty-two (22) to the quarter section corner on
the South line of said Section twenty-two (22), thence at right angles
East along the South line of the Southeast quarter of Section twenty-two
(22) and the South line of Section twenty-three (23), and the South line
of the Southwest quarter of Section twenty-four (24) to the Southeast
corner of said quarter section; thence at right angles North along the
East line of the West half of said Section twenty-four (24), and the
East line of the Southwest quarter of Section thirteen (13) to the

point of beginning, containing one thousand nine hundred and twenty acres more or less according to the Government Survey, thereof.

Your petitioners further show that there are resident of said territory, as shown by census taken by your petitioners on the 18th, day of December A.D. 1913 and within eight weeks previous to the time this petition is presented to the said Board of County Commissioners, two hundred five persons all residents in Hennepin County, Minnesota; that there is no newspaper now published in said territory so proposed to be incorporated.

Your petitioners desire that the territory herein described be incorporated into a Village under the name of the VILLAGE OF ROGERS, Hennepin County, Minnesota. All of said petitioners reside upon the lands herein described and are electors in said territory, which is not within the limits of any incorporated village and said petitioners ask your Honorable Body to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing in said lands may vote for or against such incorporation and that you make such other and further resolutions as may be necessary to carry out the wishes of your petitioners.
