To all whom it may concern:

Satisfactory evidence having been exhibited to me that Boško Vidaković has been appointed Consul General of the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia at Chicago, Illinois, for the States of Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas, and Wisconsin, I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers and privileges as are allowed to the Consuls General of the most favored Nations in the United States.

In Testimony Whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.
