We, the village council of the village of Gaylord in the county of Sibley, Minnesota, do hereby certify and return that at a special election, held at the Assembly Room of the City Hall in said village, in the county of Sibley and State of Minnesota, on the 30th. day of March 1914, to vote on the question whether such village of Gaylord will continue to exist under the acts of the legislature, and amendments thereto, by which it has heretofore been governed, and by virtue of which it was incorporated, or will relinquish the same and become reincorporated under the Revised Laws 1905; the following number of votes were cast for and against said proposition, as canvassed by us, to-wit:-

There were cast "For reincorporation" 116 votes.

There were cast "Against reincorporation" 10 votes.

A majority of the votes cast being in the affirmative it is hereby Resolved, and declared that the former charter of said village shall upon the filing of certified copies hereof as provided by law, cease, and that the village of Gaylord shall thereupon be reincorporated under the Revised Laws 1905.
