ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN DESCRIBED PROPERTY
TO THE VILLAGE

The Village Council of MAPLE GROVE Does Ordain:

The after described tract of land, having been detached from
the Village of OSSEO by resolution of the Village Council of OSSEO upon
the petitioner of the owners thereof, is hereby annexed to, and made a
part of, The Village of MAPLE GROVE;

The said tract is described as follows, to wit:

That part of Section 13, Township 119, Range 22,
commencing 30 rods West and 40 rods North of the
Southeast corner of said section; thence West
10 rods; thence North 1771-3/10 feet; thence East
10 rods; thence South 1771-3/10 feet to the point
of beginning.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and
after its passage and publication according to law, and from and after
the passage and publication of an Ordinance by the Village Council of
OSSEO, detaching said tract of land from the Village of OSSEO.
