

Ordinance No. 136

An Ordinance Annexing a Certain Outlot to the Village of Le Roy.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Village Council requesting annexation of the property herein described, the Village Council of the Village of Le Roy, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. That the following described Outlot abutting upon the incorporated Village of Le Roy, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby annexed to such Village and shall become a part of such Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Outlot Twenty Eight (28) in the southeast one quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section Twenty eight (28), Township One Hundred One (101) North, Range Fourteen (14) West, Mower County, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Mower County, Minnesota.


