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ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE
VILLAGE OF HAYFIELD.

Whereas a certain Petition dated 25th Nov 1957 requesting
annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the
Council on the 14th day of February 1958; and

Whereas it is hereby determined that the territory described
below abute upon the Village and is so subjected to the Village
Government; and

Whereas the property described below is unplatted property and
does not exceed two hundred acres; and

Whereas the Petition is signed by all of the owners of land
proposed to be annexed; Now Therefore,

The Village Council of Hayfield ordains:

Section 1 - The corporate limits of the Village of Hayfield are
hereby extended to include the following described territory situate
in the County of Dodge, State of Minnesota:

The South 825 feet of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of
the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Twenty-three (23),
Township One Hundred Five (105) North of Range Seventeen
(17) West, Dodge County, Minnesota;

Section 2 - That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file
a copy of ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in
the Office of the Auditor of Dodge County, Minnesota.

Section 3 - This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
