WHEREAS, proper apparel is essential to individual acceptance in business, industry, the professions, in school and recreation; and,

WHEREAS, it is proper and fitting that attention should be focused on the value inherent in the appropriate dress and good grooming characteristic in the American Look;

BEFORE ME, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim March 7-13, 1960 as

"DRESS RIGHT WEAR"
