







EXECUTIVE ORDER  
NUMBER

1. It having been made to appear to me that tumults, riots and mob violence have occurred in the City of Albert Lea, County of Freeborn, State of Minnesota, and the chief of police of the City of Albert Lea and the sheriff of the County of Freeborn having advised me in writing that they have not sufficient forces available with which to properly police the plant area of the Wilson & Company, Inc., and having called upon me as Commander-in-Chief of the Minnesota National Guard for assistance, the Adjutant General is hereby directed to utilize all or such portion of the Minnesota National Guard as he may deem necessary to aid the civil authorities of the City of Albert Lea and of the County of Freeborn in a restoration of peace and of law enforcement in said city and county.
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, supplies and pay will be defrayed from the general revenues of the state.
3. This order takes effect at Midnight, December 27, 1959.
