



EXECUTIVE ORDER
NUMBER 9

1. Being advised by Adjutant General Joseph E. Nelson of the Minnesota National Guard and by Richard Cook, Major General, Minnesota Army National Guard, Commander of the 47th Infantry Division, that no disorder has occurred in and about certain premises known as Wilson & Company, Inc., Albert Lea, Minnesota, since December 27, 1959 upon which date, at the request of the sheriff of the County of Freeborn and the chief of police of the City of Albert Lea, the Adjutant General was ordered by the undersigned to assist said public officers in the maintenance of law and order in and about said premises, and now being further advised by Generals Nelson and Cook that there is no present need to continue the use of troops on this assignment and that local law enforcement officials are able to maintain law and order, the Adjutant General of the Minnesota National Guard is hereby directed and ordered to forthwith withdraw from the City of Albert Lea and the County of Freeborn, Minnesota, all members of said Minnesota National Guard detailed therein for the purpose of assisting the chief of police of the City of Albert Lea and the sheriff of Freeborn County in the restoration of peace and of law enforcement in said city and county.

2. This Order takes effect immediately.
