

A PROCLAMATION FOR "FUTURE FARMER WEEK"

WHEREAS, the Future Farmers of America motto — "Learning to do, doing to learn; coming to live, living to serve" — establishes a direction of purpose for the future leaders of our nation's largest single industry, agriculture, and

WHEREAS, the Future Farmers of America main goal is to teach sound farming methods, develop leadership and promote good citizenship using the machine, thereby encouraging them to participate in community affairs and to contribute significantly to the success and progress of the agricultural economy of our state and nation, and

WHEREAS, this year marks the thirty-first anniversary of the Minnesota Association of the Future Farmers of America, an organization composed of 22,500 active members who are studying vocational agriculture in 201 secondary schools, preparing young men for careers in agriculture;

BEFORE, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 22 through 28 as
