WHEREAS, Elmer G. Vanden Heuvel and Joan T. Vanden Heuvel, his
wife, have requested annexation of a tract of land described as:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8,
Township 104 North, Range 20, thence North along
the West line of said Northwest Quarter a distance
of 182 feet, thence East a distance of 90 feet;
thence South to the South line of said Northwest
Quarter a distance of 182 feet; thence West along
the South line of said Northwest Quarter a distance
of 90 feet to the place of beginning, Freeborn
County, Minnesota, to the Village of Geneva, Minnesota;

AND WHEREAS, the council finds that said parties are the sole
owners of the tract herein described, that said tract of land
does not exceed 200 acres, that said land abuts the present village
limits, that annexation of said land to said Village of Geneva,
Minnesota, will be for the best interests of said village and of
the territory affected;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS MOVED by Councilman Myron Anderson

, seconded by Lester Goodnature

that said tract of land be and hereby is declared to be annexed
to the Village of Geneva, Minnesota.
