A PROCLAMATION FOR CIVIL SERVICE WEEK

WHEREAS, Federal employces have set high standards of integrity and performance in the service of their nation, and

WHEREAS, these high standards are made possible by a Civil Service system based solely on merit, and

WHEREAS, each year on the anniversary of the passage of the Civil Service Act of 1883, the American Federation of Government Employees sponsors special programs and activities to acquaint the public with the history and principles of the merit system,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer L. Andersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 14 through 20
as

"CIVIL SERVICE WEEK"

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to join in the observance of the seventy-ninth anniversary of the signing of the Civil Service Act.
