

A PROCLAMATION FOR "HYDRONICS WEEK"


WHEREAS, the Hydronic Heating Industry has made invaluable contribution to better and more comfortable living for our citizens; and,

WHEREAS, Minnesotans are encouraged to inform themselves of the technological and practical developments in the field of home and industrial heating, and to recognize the comfort they provide;



"HYDRONICS WEEK"


