



ORDINANCE NO. 344

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANES.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number, of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

That part of Lot C in Ludlow's Subdivision of that part of U. S. Government Lots Six (6) and Seven (7), Sec. 26, T. 102, R. 40, North of the C. St. P. M. & O. Railway, recorded on Page 140, in Book "B" of Surveyor's Record of Nobles County, Minnesota, commencing 270 feet south of the northwest corner of said Lot "C", thence 300 feet south, thence 65.33 feet east, thence 300 feet north, thence 65.33 feet west to the point of beginning; and

A tract of land in Government Lot Six (6), in Sec. 26, T. 102, R. 40, described as: Commencing at the meander corner of West Okabena Lake on the Section line between Sections 26 and 27, T. 102, R. 40, thence south on the Section line, a distance of 119 feet, to the northerly line of the County Highway, thence in an easterly direction along the northerly line of the highway a distance of 362.2 feet, thence south a distance of 83.8 feet to the southerly line of the County Highway, which is the point of beginning, thence south a distance of 279 feet, thence west a distance of 80 feet, thence north a distance of 254.2 feet to the southerly line of the County Highway, thence easterly along the southerly line of said highway, to the place of beginning, all in Nobles County, Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing descriptions, and bounded as described, is one (1) acre.

Section 3. A hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after publication of the notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

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Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
