- WHEREAS, the Memorial will be a fitting tribute to the special contact that existed between President John F. Kennedy and students everywhere, and
- WHEREAS, when students heard about the plans for the Memorial Library, they suggested a special student-given memorial within the Library, and
- WHEREAS, the National Student Committee of the John F. Kennedy Library has set May 4 through 10, 1964, for a national student drive for support for the Kennedy Library, and
- WHEREAS, many schools and students in Minnesota are participating in the national drive,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 4 through May 10, 1964, as

"KENNEDY LIBRARY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens, and students especially, to support the John F. Kennedy Memorial Library in commemoration of our late President.
