


Sir:

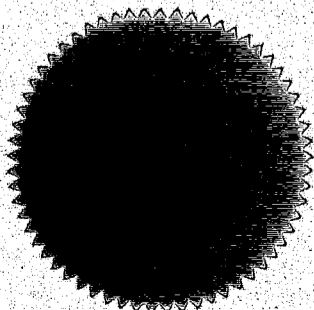

I Certify That, satisfactory evidence having been exhibited of the appointment of
Lars Gustaf Christer Cronander as Vice Consul of Sweden at Minneapolis,
Minnesota, the President of the United States of America has ordered
his recognition as such officer, declaring him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and
privileges as are allowed to the Vice Consuls of the most favored Nations in the United
States.


