PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, clothing for school, clothing for work, clothing to keep out the winter cold and clothing for self-respect-- these are vital to people, and

WHEREAS, the Save the Children Federation maintains over 100 Clothing Centers in the Southern Appalachian Mountains where people can obtain the garments and shoes at very low cost, in order to preserve the dignity of a proud people, and

WHEREAS, clothing is distributed here to encourage community self-help activities and to alleviate emergency disaster needs in various parts of the world, and

WHEREAS, many children, families and communities are waiting and hoping for help--your help,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, *Karl F. Olson*, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 1-5, 1965,

"RUSSELL DAYS"

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesotans to take an inventory of their clothes and send what they can spare to the Save the Children Federation for the need is immediate and urgent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred sixty-four and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
