
RE: Village of Osakis

Dear Mr. Donovan:

The Village of Osakis is located partly in Todd County and partly in Douglas County. The part that is in Todd County is surrounded by Gordon Township. In the past the Village has been handled as two separate districts for purposes of election and assessment. The people who lived in the part of the Village of Osakis, but located in Todd County, were considered a part of the Township for purposes of election and assessments.

The Minnesota Statutes, M. S. A. 412.081, set forth a procedure whereby a separation can be made. A vote was held in the Village on January 19, 1965, to separate the district from the Town of Gordon, and the vote was in favor thereof. The statute requires that we send a certificate to your office, and we enclose such a certificate herewith. If there is anything further you require please contact us.

CERTIFICATE OF RESULT OF SPECIAL ELECTION BY VILLAGE COUNCIL

I, Vivion Teal, the Village Clerk of the Village of Oakie in the Counties of Douglas and Todd, State of Minnesota, certify that a special election was held in said Village on the 19th day of January, 1965, to vote on the question of separating said village from the town of Gordon in Todd County as provided by law; that the council has duly canvassed the returns of said election as certified to it by the judges thereof; that at said election there were cast 104 votes for separation and 34 votes against separation; and that the result of said election was in favor of such separation.
