



ORDINANCE NO. 377

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such property included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

That part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 15, Township 102 North, Range 40 West of the 5th P.M., Nobles County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Homewood Hills First Addition, which point is the point of beginning; thence north 90 degrees 00 minutes east (assumed bearing) and along the north line of Homewood Hills First Addition for 777.5 feet; thence north 45 degrees 03 minutes east and along the northwesterly side of Homewood Hills First Addition for 107.78 feet; thence north 45 degrees 03 minutes west for 1200.94 feet; thence south 0 degrees 13 minutes west for 925.00 feet to the true point of beginning, subject to highway easements now in effect.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded and described is 7.4 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on May 18, 1965, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
