

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the American Trial Lawyers Association of 20,000 members in 50 state chapters will actively campaign during February to reduce the tragic slaughter which takes place daily on our highways, and

WHEREAS, more people have been killed through highway accidents than in all of our wars from the American Revolution to Viet Nam, and

WHEREAS, the Trial Lawyers by their campaign and their recommendations will call public attention to what must be done to alleviate this senseless carnage,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvang, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February, 1966, as

"STOP MURDER BY MOTOR MURDER"

in Minnesota, and urge widest possible dissemination of the tragic facts of highway carelessness.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-sixth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
