

ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLERNIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLERNIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Petitions have been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Willernie, Minnesota, by all or a majority in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Willernie, Minnesota:

Lots Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), Block Seven (7), Glenmar,, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Six (6) Glenmar, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots Five (5) and Six (6) Imsdahl's Rearrangement, County of Washington, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota.

Section 2. That a public hearing was duly held insofar as said Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Six (6) of Glenmar were concerned on December 17th, 1964, a majority having signed the petition for the annexation of said lots.

Section 3. A quantity of land embraced in the foregoing description is 1.86 acres.

Section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Willernie, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WILKERNIE, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. Petitions have been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Wilkernie, Minnesota, by all or a majority in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Wilkernie, Minnesota:

Lots Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), Block Seven (7), Glenmar, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Six (6) Glenmar, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, and

Lots Five (5) and Six (6) Insdahl's Rearrangement, County of Washington, as surveyed and platted and now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota.

Section 2. That a public hearing was duly held insofar as said Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8), Block Six (6) of Glenmar were concerned on December 17th, 1964, a majority having signed the petition for the annexation of said lots.

Section 3. A quantity of land embraced in the foregoing description is 1.86 acres.

Section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Wilkernie, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.


