



ORDINANCE NO. 347

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by all the owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, Range Forty-one (41) West of the 5th Principal Meridian in Lyon County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the south right-of-way line of State Trunk Highway No. 19 as now laid out and constructed which is 972 feet easterly of the west line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 3; thence in a southerly direction at right angles a distance of 175 feet as the place of beginning; thence southerly along the last described line a distance of 65 feet, thence westerly at right angles a distance of 203 feet, thence northerly a distance of 65 feet, thence easterly at right angles 203 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.34 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 0.34 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be in the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
