NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF CONTRACT BETWEEN  
J.B. COOK AND SON AND THE SAINT PAUL UNION  
DEPOT COMPANY, EXECUTED FEBRUARY 1, 1899.

To J.B. COOK AND SON, COOK'S ST. PAUL OMNIBUS & CARRIAGE  
COMPANY AND COOK'S TAXI-CAB & TRANSFER COMPANY;

Saint Paul, Minnesota:

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that The Saint Paul Union Depot Company is now under Federal Control and is operated by W.G. McAdoo, Director General of Railroads, and that as such Director General he does hereby terminate at midnight of Monday, the 30th day of September, 1918, the contract between J.B. Cook and Son and The Saint Paul Union Depot Company, executed February 1, 1899, granting certain privileges on or about the premises and tracks of said depot, and J.B. Cook and Son, their successors and assigns, and each of them, are hereby required to discontinue their activities on or about the premises and tracks of said Depot Company on or before said date.
