

ORDINANCE NO. 419

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, except the City of Worthington, to have such property included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota; and whereas, the City of Worthington owns a portion of said property which is situated outside of, but contiguous to, and abutting on the corporate limits of the City, and the City Council has determined to have such land also included within the City of Worthington:

Lots Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10) and the Westerly Twenty-Five (25) feet of Lot Eleven (11), all in Auditor's Plat of Bass Outlots in Section 26, Township 102, Range 40, Nobles County, Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described is 6.12 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on August 14, 1967, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and that the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Worthington as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commissioner, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
