PROCLAMATION *Joseph L. Anderson*
Secretary of State

WHEREAS, the national school lunch program, for more than twenty years, has convincingly demonstrated the vital role of good nutrition in the total educational process of the Nation's children, and

WHEREAS, the program is an outstanding example of a federal-state-local partnership making effective use of our food abundance and protecting the health and well-being of all our children, regardless of their race or ability to pay, and

WHEREAS, this year, under this program, some 20 million children in over 71,000 public and non-profit private schools will enjoy nutritious, appetizing lunches, and

WHEREAS, increased federal, state, and local efforts will help additional thousands of children from low income families to obtain lunches that will strengthen their vitality and their ability to obtain maximum benefits from the learning process,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 8-14, 1967, as

"SCHOOL LUNCH WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge activities designed to increase public understanding and awareness of the significance of the national school lunch program to the child, to the home, to the farm, to industry, and to the Nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in the City of Saint Paul this twenty-eighth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and of the State, the one hundred tenth.
