WRIT AND PROCLAMATION OF
SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY
IN THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR IN
AND FOR THE FORTY-THIRD SENATORIAL
DISTRICT OF THE STATE.

A vacancy having arisen in the office of state senator in and for the Forty-third Senatorial District of the State of Minnesota, by reason of the resolution of the Senate, declaring that W.W.Wilcox did not receive a legal majority of the votes legally cast at the last election and is not entitled to hold and retain his seat as a senator;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Minnesota, under Section 17 of Article 4 of the Constitution of the state, and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 5 Session Laws of Minnesota, 1919, I, as such Governor, do hereby direct that a special election be held in the Forty-third Senatorial District aforesaid on the 20th day of February, 1919, to fill the vacancy existing in the office aforesaid, candidates to be nominated and such election to be held, and all things pertaining thereto to be done, as provided under the provisions of Chapter 5 aforesaid.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand, at the Capitol in the City of St. Paul, this 1st., day of February, 1919.
