


I hereby appoint M. W. Brewster, Esquire, of Wells, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to act on the State Fair Grounds during the fair of 1919, and for such time as may be necessary thereafter to act at that place. Action to be taken as to all matters arising upon the State Fair Grounds in such a way as to require the immediate action of an assistant attorney general or a prosecuting attorney.

This appointment is upon the recommendation of the Board of Directors of the State Agricultural Society and upon my judgment that the public welfare will be promoted by said appointment. The compensation is hereby fixed at fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per day, the same to be paid from the funds of the said state agricultural society.




